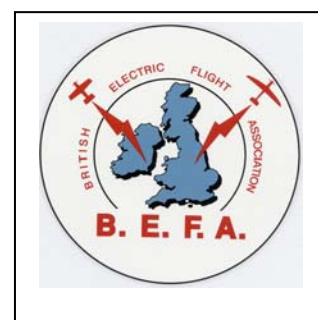

Entry Fees

AS previously stated, all fees are to be paid by Bank Transfer in Pounds Sterling (GBP). The actual fees should be in accordance with the following figures:-

World Championship entry fees will be **165 GBP** for each competitor and team manager, and **30 GBP** for each official helper. A formal protest will require a fee of **25 GBP**.

Open event entry fees will be **25 GBP** for each competitor.

For these events, the protest fee will be **10 GBP**.

Tickets to the Banquet will be **30 GBP**.

The deadlines for the receipt of official entries and fees will be on the basis of:-

- Official entry including competitors names (as detailed in Bulletin 2) 10th May 2004.
- All entry fees by bank transfer (in GBP) 31st May 2004.

Entry fees received up to 30 days after 31st May will incur a 10% penalty. Any received more than 30 days after 31st May will incur a 20% penalty.

Under no circumstances will fees be accepted at the time of the event in cash.

Entry fees include model flying insurance under the BMFA scheme (details on BMFA website – www.bmfa.org).

Payment is to be made in accordance with the details provided with the Official Forms.

Please Note Entry to the competition flying area will be restricted to the organisers and fee paying team managers/members/helpers as detailed on the Official Entry Form.

Camp Site Fees These fees (in accordance with the information in Bulletin1) may be paid in GBP on arrival. The rates will be :-

Small tent – **7 GBP** per day (**40 GBP** for full event)

Large tent/caravan/mobile home - **15 GBP** per day (**80 GBP** for full event)

Pre- booking of sites is not now necessary but it would help if prospective users would let the organisers know of their intentions by email.

Banquet The banquet will be held in the York racecourse (Knavesmire) banqueting facilities. The ticket price for the banquet will be **30 GBP** which is to be submitted at the same time as the competitors' entry fees for those wishing to attend.

Radio Frequencies

Frequencies.

Frequencies for the World Championship events have already been agreed with all preliminary entrants. Other entrants will be allocated frequencies on the basis of availability. In the case of the Open events frequencies are being agreed as entries are received and all those considering entry should contact

the competition liaison officer by email as soon as possible [George.Shering@btopenworld.com] who will advise on frequency choice and allocation.

Outline Schedule

Each day of competition flying (except for the Sunrise/Sunset competition) will commence at 8.00 am. The typical day will be broken into three blocks as follows:-

8.00 am to 12.00 noon	F5B
12.00 noon to 3.00 pm	F5D
3.00 pm to close	F5B

Note for F5D – The intention of the CD is to fly an intensive schedule based on 5 minutes per group and to complete four rounds each day (40 minutes per round). This will be critical in terms of model and flyer preparation.
